

## Government Introduces Companies Compliance Facilitation Scheme, 2026 (CCFS-2026)

The **Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA)** has announced a **one-time Compliance Facilitation Scheme** aimed at enabling companies to regularise pending statutory filings with **substantially reduced fees and condonation of delay**.

The scheme, titled **Companies Compliance Facilitation Scheme, 2026 (CCFS-2026)**, will be operational for a **three-month window from 15 April 2026 to 15 July 2026**.

### Overview of the Scheme

With the number of active companies in India crossing **20 lakh**, the MCA has taken this initiative in response to representations from stakeholders, including **startups, MSMEs, private companies, and producer companies**, who faced challenges in completing statutory compliances on time, leading to significant additional fee burdens.

CCFS-2026 provides companies a structured opportunity to **regularise past non-compliances**, rationalise compliance costs, and realign with statutory requirements.

### Key Highlights of CCFS-2026

#### ✔ One-Time Compliance Window

- Companies may file **pending statutory and annual filings** during the scheme period.
- Delays in filings shall be **condoned** upon availing the scheme.

#### 💰 Significant Reduction in Additional Fees

- Only **10% of the total additional fees** otherwise payable for delayed filings will be required to be paid under the scheme.

#### 🛑 Dormant Company Option

- Companies intending to be classified as **Dormant Companies** may file the prescribed application by paying **50% of the normal filing fees**.
- Dormant status enables inactive companies to remain on the register with **minimal ongoing compliance obligations**.

#### ✘ Strike-Off Facility

- Companies wishing to apply for **strike-off** may do so by paying **25% of the applicable filing fees**.

### Ineligible Companies

The scheme shall **not be available** to certain categories of companies, including:

- Companies against which **action for striking off** has already been initiated by the Registrar of Companies

- Other categories as may be specified by the MCA from time to time
-
